



Protestants quote 1 Timothy 2:5 as supposed 'proof' against the invocation of Saints, because Christ is the one Mediator. However, Christ also states that He is the only Shepherd, but then goes on to appoint Peter and the Apostles. Christ is also the only Judge, but the Saints will judge with Him. Catholics understand that all mediation comes from Christ, Whose Divine Mediatorship is the example we follow. (Cf. John 10:16; John 21:17; Eph 4:11; John 9:39; 1 Corinth 6:2; Matt 19:28)

Although the Protestant asserts that to pray to a Saint is to somehow circumvent the Mediatorship of Christ, yet the Protestant does that very same thing when he asks for his neighbour, or Protestant brother, to pray for him, as these pyramids show.
